

Test of Writing for Children in Kannada-TOWCK

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The present study aimed at developing a tool to assess the acquisition of writing in children studying in Kannada medium schools. The test was administered individually. The results indicated that children at 3-4 years of age have acquired writing skills. Writing skills begin to emerge at this age with copying and gradually with increase in age, writing to dictation, sentence completion etc., are acquired. The study showed that writing is not fully developed even at 7-8 years of age. It was also observed that practice, training and education could effect the writing.

Limitation:

The study had limited number of subjects.

Implications:

1. The copying skills can be retained in the test battery for testing the younger children (3-4 years and 4-5 years).
2. This test can be tried on a large sample.
